

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF

RESOLUTION NO. 70-1617**

**RESOLUTION TO RESCIND RESOLUTION NO. 27-0607, A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT
COLLABORATIVE FOR HIGH PERFORMANCE SCHOOLS DESIGN CRITERIA FOR ALL DISTRICT
CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

WHEREAS, the West Contra Costa Unified School District ("District") previously adopted Resolution No. 27-0607, directing staff to expand the District's efforts to ensure that every new school, new building and modernization project, from the beginning of the design process, incorporate the Collaborative for High Performance Schools (CHPS) design criteria; and

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 2015, as a result of Senate Bill 869 Chapter 39, Statutes of 2014, the State Allocation Board no longer allocates or approves High Performance Incentive grants; and

WHEREAS, the District will no longer incorporate CHPS design criteria into the District's school construction program; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding CHPS, the District is required to comply with the California Green Building Standards Code, California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 11 (CALGreen); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the CALGreen code is similar to the purpose of CHPS design criteria to improve public health, safety and general welfare by enhancing the design and construction of buildings through the use of building concepts having a reduced negative impact or positive environmental impact and encouraging sustainable construction practices in (1) planning and design; (2) energy efficiency; (3) water efficiency and conservation; (4) material conservation and resource efficiency; and (5) environmental quality.

NOW THEREFORE, the Governing Board of the District hereby finds, determines, declares, orders, and resolves as follows:

1. That the foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. That the District's Governing Board hereby declares that it is in the best interests of the District to rescind Resolution 27-0607.
3. That the District's Governing Board hereby authorizes the District's Superintendent, and/or his designee, pursuant to this Resolution to take any action which is necessary to carry out, give effect to, or comply with the terms and intent of this Resolution and consistent with the District Policy.
