

Purpose: Board subcommittees are high level committees dedicated to District policy.

Standing Board Subcommittees	Description
These subcommittees meet quarterly and/or “at the call of the chair”.	
Academic Subcommittee	Guides academic policy and operations , engages teacher representatives from each school who carry information from the committee back to sites.
Budget Audit Subcommittee	Guides budget policy and operations, reviews the alignment of resources to Board goals. Coordinates with various District advisory committees on budget matters. Guides site based budgeting operations and its relation to the Local Control Accountability Plan. Reviews all audit reports with the respective auditors.
Facilities Subcommittee	Guides bond, construction, facilities Management and Operations policy.
Governance Subcommittee	Guides Board governance by addressing governance measures such as the Board Bylaws, Board policy change reviews, and completing the detail work on a Board governance handbook.
Safety and Climate Subcommittee	Guides K12 safety and climate policy.

Commissions, Citizen and Parent Committees	Description
Citizens Bond Oversight Committee	Provides citizen input into the finance and implementation of WCCUSD's school renewal program. Reviews annual finance and performance audits.
Citizens Oversight Committee for Parcel Taxes	Ensures that tax funds are spent according to ballot measure language and report annually to the Board and to the public regarding the expenditure of such monies.
District Budget Engagement Committee	Review and understand the impact of federal, state and local funding on the District's budget and to make recommendations to the Board regarding budget priorities, efficiency or cost reduction strategies, consider the reserve level that is best for the District as well as reviewing the most effective means of presenting budget information to the public.
Youth Commission	Provides student representatives from all high schools opportunity to inform the Board on issues of importance to our youth.
Solutions Team	Workgroup comprised of all bargaining units, Asst Sup for HR, the Superintendent and Board.

Multilingual District Advisory Committee	Provides engagement opportunity for parents of English Learners.
Community Advisory Committee for Special Education	Parent/community advisory committee for Special Ed required by federal law.
District Local Control Accountability Committee	Parent/student advisory committee required by the local control funding formula.
Technology Committee	Guides Information Technology integration into school and classroom
