Existing contract description: WCCUSD's trained coaches offer 8 to 14 individual writing conferences of 20 to 45 minutes during the year to every student in a classroom. These one-to-one coaching sessions benefit every student, providing the differentiated instruction that remains an elusive goal in most public schools. The tutoring will support students in learning to think critically and to express their ideas clearly and confidently in writing, which are skills crucial to college and workplace success. Community Alliance will provide data to show the progress the students show.
