**WHEREAS**, he is a product of local schools, attending Mira Vista Elementary School and Adams Middle School and graduating from Kennedy High School in 1968, Contra Costa College in 1971, and UC Berkeley in 1973; and

**WHEREAS**, he taught social science to generations of students at Harry Ells, Richmond, and Kennedy high schools; and

**WHEREAS**, he coached generations of student athletes at Kennedy, Harry Ells and De Anza high schools; and

**WHEREAS**, he served as an assistant principal at El Cerrito and Richmond high schools and as principal at Gompers Continuation High School, Portola (now Korematsu) Middle School, and Omega High School before retiring in 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, during his tenure on the Board of Education, the District saw an increase in the percentage of students prepared for college and career, expanded professional development opportunities for classroom teachers, and implemented a robust technology plan to help prepare our students for the 21<sup>st</sup> century; and

**WHEREAS**, he has provided leadership for the District by serving as Board President in 2015-2016; and

**WHEREAS**, as a member of the Board Safety/Climate Subcommittee he helped implement numerous improvements to provide safer school facilities, more positive school climates, enhanced emergency preparedness training, better staff utilization and increased communication among schools and families to provide more secure campuses and safer school events; and

**WHEREAS**, as a member of the Board Academic Subcommittee, he helped implement numerous improvements to the instructional program that has resulted in increased academic achievement for all students and increased access to professional development for our classroom teachers.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board of Education, students, faculty, parents, staff, and community, extend to Randall Enos our sincere gratitude and appreciation for his 39 years of dedicated service to the West Contra Costa Unified School District community.
